Consideration of award for Dowdle Mountain Road sewer line extension

Sam Greenwood said we opened the bids on the Dowdle Mountain Road sewer line extension on May 24, 2011. He said the low bidder was Iron Mountain Construction Company in the amount of \$333,089.68. Copies of the bids are attached. Mr. Greenwood said the project will cost more due to having to bore under the 4-lane highway. He said the additional cost will be around \$130,000.00. He said this extension will increase the service area and also service the new Super Wal-Mart. He said the extension will stop at the edge of the North Carolina Department of Transportation right of way. Mr. Greenwood said the developer for Wal-Mart will be paying \$160,000.00 of the cost. He said the contract will be signed after July 1 and the completion time will be five months.

Motion was made by Curtis, seconded by Mashburn to award the bid in the amount of \$333,089.68 to Iron Mountain Construction Company for the Dowdle Mountain Road sewer line extension. Motion carried. Vote: 6 to 0.
