The Franklin Town Council held its monthly meeting on August 2, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall Board Room. Mayor Robert S. Scott presided. Vice Mayor Jack Horton, Council Members Joe Collins, Mike Lewis, and Dinah Mashburn were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice-Mayor Jack Horton.

# Motion was made by Collins, seconded by Horton to excuse Council Member David Culpepper from the meeting. Motion carried. Vote: 4 to 0.

#### New Business: Agreement for Installation of Duke Energy EV Fast Charging Station

Interim Town Manager Setser said Duke Energy has proposed to install fast charging station in the public parking area below Town Hall. He said it would be no cost to the Town and would use two to three parking spaces.

Motion was made by Collins, seconded by Mashburn to approve the Agreement for Installation of Duke Energy EV Fast Charging Station. Motion carried. Vote: 4 to 0.

## New Business: Discussion on the Christmas Parade

Council Member Horton said that he and Police Chief Bill Harrell had met with the Chamber of Commerce to discuss options for being able to keep the annual Christmas Parade from being canceled.

He said that \$1,200 from the fund balance could be moved into the Police Overtime budget to provide the officers needed for the event. He said that the Franklin Chamber of Commerce believes they can find the volunteers to make the event happen.

Council Member Collins said he would like to see the formation of an auxiliary group to help with events such as the Christmas Parade in the future.

Motion was made by Horton, seconded by Lewis to move \$1,200 from the Town's Fund Balance to Police Overtime in order to help with the Christmas Parade. Motion carried. Vote: 4 to 0.
